History of EuroCollege

- A centre of interdisciplinary studies (comparative politics, economics, international relations, public administration, law, history)
- Operating since 1998
 - Originally (from 1993) as EuroFaculty
- Main centre for English language teaching at University of Tartu

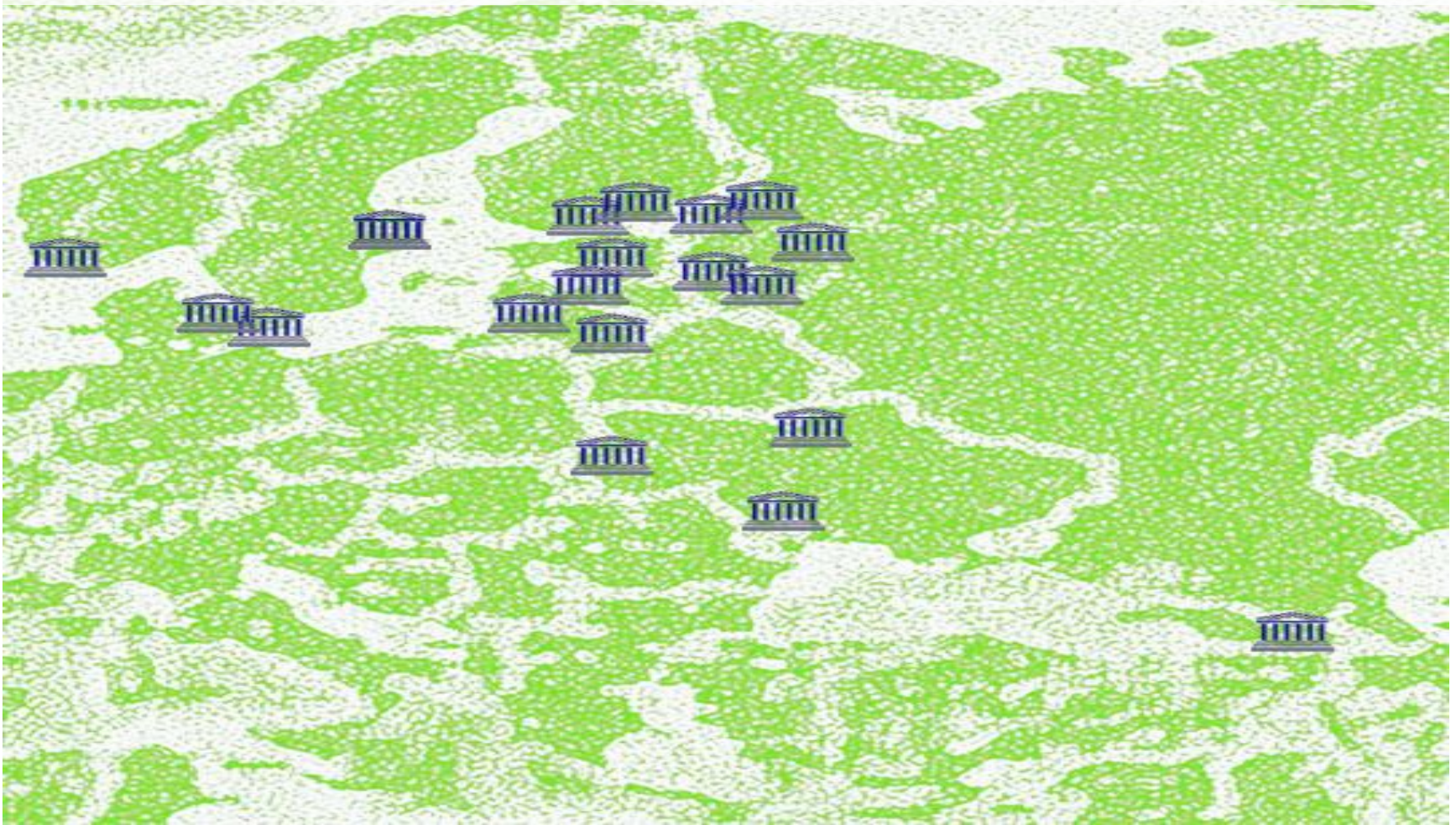
Prometheus Programme

- Semester-based study programme
 - Study start September and February
- Interdisciplinary programme
 - Transition Studies (economic, legal, political)
 - Covering Eastern Europe and FSU as a whole
 - EU courses (theory, history, practice)
 - International Relations (Cold War and Post-CW)
 - Access to EURUS MA courses on Russia
- Open to all international students at UT
 - Erasmus students and students on bilateral agreements
 - Also open to local students

EU-Russia MA Programme

- Two year MA programme (120ECTS)
 - Interdisciplinary approach drawing on humanities, social sciences, law, and economics
- General module
 - Introduction to the two main actors, EU and Russia
 - Theoretical courses on regionalism and EU integration
 - Economic and political developments
 - Language course in either Russian or other major European language
- Specialisation
 - Optional courses focusing on either EU or Russia

International cooperation



International cooperation

- Transition Studies Network
 - Supported by the Estonian MFA
 - Specifically targeting partner institutions in Ukraine, Moldova and Georgia
 - Student scholarships to study in Tartu for 1-2 semesters
- Nordplus
 - Provides scholar visits to partner institutions
 - Annual workshops to discuss curriculum developments and exchange experiences
 - 2009 International Spring School on Transition Studies



Spring School on Transition Studies, April 2009

- Five day event hosted in Tartu
- 16 lecturers from Tartu and partner institutions (Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Georgia, Germany, Lithuania, Moldova, Ukraine)
 - Thematic presentations on current research
- 40 students from partner institutions
